One official high school transcript if you have less than 24 hours prior college or a college transcript if you have at least 24 hours of college credit (please allow at least 2 weeks to receive transcript from your school)

Two letters of recommendation:

1. An academic letter of recommendation from a school administrator, counselor or teacher or supervisor or work colleague
2. A personal letter of recommendation from a responsible person in your community who knows you well and can attest to your personal qualities and abilities. A family member or casual acquaintance may not write this letter.

Additional documents may be requested upon review of the application.
